☉ Remember: Please bring your dessert in a DISPOSABLE CONTAINER.

## Give & Receive Tents:

**Saturday, May 22, from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm**

Please do not bring items on Sunday morning—we'll have to refuse them because there will be too much going on!

# What should I bring for the Give & Receive Tents? Be led!



**Clothes:** They should be clean, pressed, on hangers, and tagged (on the hanger) with the correct size and category—for example, Men's L, Girls 6X, Infant 18 mos, Ladies 12, etc. Do not bring your clothes in bags, or they will be returned to you.



**Shoes:** Must be clean, not muddy or stinky, in matching sets. Please clip together and mark the size.



**Jewelry:** It should be in good condition—not broken, and with no missing pieces or parts. If it is **REAL GOLD** and/or has precious stones, be sure to turn it in at the Information Counter by Friday, May 21.



**Miscellaneous Items:** Toys, Bicycles, Small Appliances, Home Décor, Lawn Appliances and Equipment, Woodshop Tools, etc. All items should be in good working order, with no broken or missing pieces.



**Large and Heavy Items:** Large Appliances, Furniture, Lawn Mowers, Recreational Equipment, TVs, etc.

**Pantry Items:** non-perishable food items (canned goods, cereals, mixes, spices, flour, pasta, etc.), paper products (like towels, toilet paper)

**Baby Items:** diapers, formula, wipes, baby supplies

**Important!** Do not bring junk. It will go directly into the trash dumpster.

**\*\*For safety purposes, to receive any item—except clothing—you must sign a release.\*\***
